## **Bazetta Township Police Department** 2019 Recruitment and Hiring Qualifications

## **Christopher G. Herlinger, Chief of Police**

A Candidate must meet or exceed the following qualifications to be considered for a position with the Bazetta Township Police Department.

The candidate must be:

- 1. 21 years of age
- 2. Ohio Resident
- 3. Certified by the Ohio Peace Officers Academy as a Police Officer

The candidate selection process consists of nine or ten steps and the Candidate will need to meet or exceed these qualifications to be considered for a position:

- 1. Written Response
- 2. Oral Panel
- 3. Scenario

An accumulative score of 70% of the first three steps is required to move on to steps 4, 5 and 6.

- 4. Driving Record
- 5. Criminal History
- 6. Background Investigation

Candidates must successfully complete steps 4, 5 and 6 to be considered qualified for a conditional hiring. At the discretion of the Chief of Police, a candidate will be recommended to the Bazetta Township Trustees to be approved for a conditional hiring pending the candidate passing the final steps 7, 8 and 9.

- 7. Physical Examination
- 8. Drug Screen
- 9. Psychological Examination

The Chief of Police, with approval of the Bazetta Township Trustees, may waive individual steps of the selection process for certain non-sworn positions (e.g. custodial and IT manager).

All qualifications in the selection process are conducted under the guidelines of Bazetta Township and departmental policies and procedures.
