



**RESOLUTION TO LET BID FOR HILLSIDE CEMETERY PROJECT
(Storage Building Construction - Chapel Repair - Landscaping)**

WHEREAS, the Bazetta Township Board of Trustees has determined that the township is in need of a capital improvement project pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Chapter 153, to-wit: construction of a cemetery storage building, chapel repairs, landscaping, hereinafter referred to collectively as the Hillside Cemetery Improvement Project to replace the prior existing accessory storage building that was destroyed and cemetery chapel damaged by a tornado passing through the cemetery .

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED that the Bazetta Township Board of Trustees be and hereby authorizes to let for competitive public bid the construction of a township capital improvement , to-wit: Hillside Cemetery Improvement Project , and to take any and all actions necessary to provide for the construction and acquisition of the public improvement.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bazetta Township Board of Trustees will publish a Notice of Bid for the proposed capital improvement project once a week for not less than three (3) consecutive weeks preceding the day of the opening of the bids, with the last date of publication being no later than eight (8) days before the opening of the sealed bids; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Bazetta Township Board of Trustees will solicit and accept sealed bids in accordance with Ohio Revised Code Chapter 153;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that arrangements to pick up copies of the bid specifications may be made by contacting the Township Fiscal Officer at 330-637-8816, or going to the office of the fiscal officer, the Township Administrative Building 3372 State Route 5, Cortland, Ohio 44410 during regular business hours.

Good Morning Sir(s),

We finished the grading process with ISO and the resulting public protection classification is Class 3/3Y effective August 26, 2019! (Class 1 is the best possible grade and Class 10 is the worst)

This is an improvement from the Class 4/4Y rating that Bazetta Township had previously held and this improvement may significantly lower the property insurance costs for businesses and residents located in our service area.

This improved grade reflects the dedication and hard work that our personnel do every day and the great support that we are given by our community and partners. I would be remiss if I do not recognize Aaron Hanson as this gentlemen put a lot of time and effort into this project.

As of last year, of the approximately 42,000 fire departments in the United States with fewer than 5,500 achieved a PPC grade of Class 3 or better. This places Bazetta Township's grade in the top 14% of all fire departments nationally and tied with 2 other communities for best in Trumbull County.

We wish to thank you and Chief Dennis Lewis for your cooperation during our recent Public Protection Classification (PPC) survey. ISO has completed its analysis of the structural fire suppression delivery system provided in your community. The resulting classification is indicated above.

If you would like to know more about your community's PPC classification, or if you would like to learn about the potential effect of proposed changes to your fire suppression delivery system, please call us at the phone number listed below.

ISO's Public Protection Classification Program (PPC) plays an important role in the underwriting process at insurance companies. In fact, most U.S. insurers – including the largest ones – use PPC information as part of their decision-making when deciding what business to write, coverage's to offer or prices to charge for personal or commercial property insurance.

Each insurance company independently determines the premiums it charges its policyholders. The way an insurer uses ISO's information on public fire protection may depend on several things – the company's fire-loss experience, ratemaking methodology, underwriting guidelines, and its marketing strategy.

Through ongoing research and loss experience analysis, we identified additional differentiation in fire loss experience within our PPC program, which resulted in the revised classifications. We based the differing fire loss experience on the fire suppression capabilities of each community. The new classifications will improve the predictive value for insurers while benefiting both commercial and residential property owners. We've published the new classifications as "X" and "Y" — formerly the "9" and "8B" portion of the split classification, respectively. For example:

- A community currently graded as a split 6/9 classification will now be a split 6/6X classification; with the "6X" denoting what was formerly classified as "9."
- Similarly, a community currently graded as a split 6/8B classification will now be a split 6/6Y classification, the "6Y" denoting what was formerly classified as "8B."

- Communities graded with single "9" or "8B" classifications will remain intact.
- Properties over 5 road miles from a recognized fire station would receive a class 10.

PPC is important to communities and fire departments as well. Communities whose PPC improves may get lower insurance prices. PPC also provides fire departments with a valuable benchmark, and is used by many departments as a valuable tool when planning, budgeting and justifying fire protection improvements.

ISO appreciates the high level of cooperation extended by local officials during the entire PPC survey process. The community protection baseline information gathered by ISO is an essential foundation upon which determination of the relative level of fire protection is made using the Fire Suppression Rating Schedule.

The classification is a direct result of the information gathered, and is dependent on the resource levels devoted to fire protection in existence at the time of survey. Material changes in those resources that occur after the survey is completed may affect the classification. Although ISO maintains a pro-active process to keep baseline information as current as possible, in the event of changes please call us at 1-800-444-4554, option 2 to expedite the update activity.

ISO is the leading supplier of data and analytics for the property/casualty insurance industry. Most insurers use PPC classifications for underwriting and calculating premiums for residential, commercial and industrial properties. The PPC program is not intended to analyze all aspects of a comprehensive structural fire suppression delivery system program. It is not for purposes of determining compliance with any state or local law, nor is it for making loss prevention or life safety recommendations.

PPC Review

ISO concluded its review of the fire suppression features being provided for Bazetta TS. The resulting community classification is **Class 03/3Y**.

If the classification is a single class, the classification applies to properties with a Needed Fire Flow of 3,500 gpm or less in the community. If the classification is a split class (e.g., 6/XX):

- The first class (e.g., "6" in a 6/XX) applies to properties within 5 road miles of a recognized fire station and within 1,000 feet of a fire hydrant or alternate water supply.
- The second class (XX or XY) applies to properties beyond 1,000 feet of a fire hydrant but within 5 road miles of a recognized fire station.
- Alternative Water Supply: The first class (e.g., "6" in a 6/10) applies to properties within 5 road miles of a recognized fire station with no hydrant distance requirement.
- Class 10 applies to properties over 5 road miles of a recognized fire station.
- Class 10W applies to properties within 5 to 7 road miles of a recognized fire station with a recognized water supply within 1,000 feet.
- Specific properties with a Needed Fire Flow in excess of 3,500 gpm are evaluated separately and assigned an individual classification.

Hello All - please find attached the Park Board minutes from 8-20-19 meeting. Trustees-after reviewing Play By Design inspection report, kindly notify Board of any maintenance the Township will perform on Imagination Station Playground. I realize the report was already sent but I have included a rough outline of Priority #1's as noted by Play By Design (see below). Upon notification from Trustees, the Board can then discuss a plan to use 'improvement' monies for other work that is needed. The fact that the wood structure is still in good condition (some boards are still 'green') was very positive news! Someone has offered to donate a sliding board which would help out with #13. Thank you for working with the Board on recommending an inspection and keeping the Park open:)
Laura

- 1) Handrails & Balusters: Recommendation-Sand & seal all exposed framing. Rout edges with ¼" radius so the top of the boards is less than 2" of a flat surface. Some areas are too damaged to fix, consider replacing with a structural plastic lumber material. Balusters can be replaced with 2x2 plastic lumber.
- 2) Mulch/Engineered Wood Fiber (EWF): Recommendation-Bring EWF to 12" deep especially under swings and slide exits. Repaint the painted depth markings to facilitate future maintenance. Where there are no stripes, measure up 12" from the bottom of the EWF to locate new stripes
- 3) Fasteners: Recommendation-Replace failing/rusting fasteners with new corrosion-resistant fasteners/hardware at all connections. Fasteners cannot be loosened without tools; nuts and bolts are self-locking or have a means to prevent detachment.
- 4) Play Element-Sound Wall: Recommendation-Add filler pieces so spacing is >3- 1/2".
- 5) Play Element-Low Trapeze Rings: Recommendation-Replace rusting hardware with new hardware that's corrosion-resistant. Close all S-Hooks to meet ASTM requirements. Replace decaying post with new PT-Wood or a weather resistance structural plastic.
- 6) Play Element Spider Net: Recommendation-Tighten chains or replace with new complaint net that's made of newer material. Remove or replace with different element?
- 7) Play Element-Chain Bridge: Recommendation-Tighten chains or replace with new compliant net that's made of newer material.
- 8) Play Element-Cradle Bridge: Recommendation-Tighten chains or replace with new compliant net that's made of newer material. Close off openings to less than 15"
- 9) Play Element-Trolley: Recommendation- Remove track ride and replace.
- 10) Play Element-Swings: Recommendation-Replace swing hangers and brackets with new. Replace all rusted hardware as well. Close S- Hooks.
- 11) Play Element-Tire Swing: Recommendation-Adjust tire swing seat so there's 12" allowance from finish grade to bottom of tire swing seat. Replace tire swivel.
- 12) Play Element-Chain Rope Climber: Recommendation-Replace with a new complaint rope climb. Add hand grasp component. Add filler pieces to reduce opening>15".
- 13) Play Element-Left Turn Slide: Recommendation-Replace slide that allows enough clearance (6' clearance). Add filler pieces to close space >3-1/2".
- 14) Play Element-Phone Box and Tower Area: Recommendation- Add filler pieces to close space >3-1/2".
- 15) Play Element-Tire Bridge and 2x6 Post / Cradle Bridge Area: Recommendation-Add filler pieces to close space >3-1/2 space.
- 16) Play Element-Wave Slide Step Area: Recommendation-Add filler pieces to close space >3-1/2".
- 17) Play Element-Wave Slide: Recommendation-Secure wave slide to side of rails. Close space at slide.
- 18) Play Element-Tot Lot Slide: Recommendation-Install new maintenance free balusters at the tot slide deck in compliance measurements.
- 19) Play Element-Tot Lot Swings: Recommendation-Replace swing hangers and brackets. Replace all rusted hardware. Close S-Hooks. Yellow Bucket seat needs

replaced and hung at proper level.
