WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the ten mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said <u>Bazetta Township</u>, Trumbull County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, a resolution declaring the necessity of levying a tax under RC §5573.09, RC §5705.03, RC §5705.19(G) and RC §5705.191 outside the ten mill limitation must be passed and certified to the County Auditor in order to permit the Board to consider the levy of such a tax and must request that the County Auditor certify to the Board of Trustees the total current tax valuation of Bazetta Township and the dollar amount of revenue that would be generated by the tax; therefore be it
