- Currently digging foundations in the cemetery and all the road patching is complete. We are mowing 40 plus acres a week now. We fixed a dip on Durst Clagg Road. The truck is still in limbo.

Zoning Inspector Pete Pizzulo to report:

- In the month of April there were 5 permits issued in the amount of \$2306.00 dollars. To date the total revenue brought in is amount \$8470.79 which is quite high for this time of year and there are several new homes in the process of being approved. Several developers have inquired about creating a PUD a land urban development with smaller lots more densely populated than your normal lot sizes. They would have to make an application for a Zone Change for that land prior to moving forward.
- We did not receive any bids from mowing contractors to mow properties that are not being kept by the owners and am asking to extend the bid acceptance time to May 20, 2022
- We received the legal opinion regarding the Church AT Warren out building and this issue should be resolved by week.

Comments:

Paul Carlson of Lakeshore Drive:

- Asked how Brenda Farone become appointed to the zoning Board? Trustee Hovis replied she was the alternate member who was moved into the vacated position by vote of the Zoning Commission. Mr Carlson asked if there were no alternate would the position be advertised? Trustee Hovis replied to the Board of Trustees would pass a resolution to accept applications
- On April 26th meeting you passed a resolution to regarding recalculating pension benefits. Trustee Hovis explained they are retired Delphi employees who many live in our community and they passed a resolution in support of the act to restore the benefits they lost and were entitled to from the beginning
- He has not seen any movement on the roads the public needs to know where these ARP funds the township is receiving is going. Trustee Hovis explained they have had meetings that were advertised to the public, he has been on the news, and no one was in attendance. They have been speaking about how they will use the funds and he has put together a proposal to submit to the other trustees. The Trustees have had to fund the Fire Departments budget last year with 200,000.00 dollars and another 175,000.00 this year. Our goal is to get that budget tackled and they announced at the last meeting Chief Rink is 5% under budget so far this year. They are making decisions on ARP funds and the roads soon.
- Trustee McBride stated that his heart is on the roads. As far as he is concerned the money should go to the roads. He feels the \$600,00.00 dollars should go to roads

- Trustee Morelli explained the rules on the funds have changed and so we have more options with the funds than we had originally. We need to coordinate with Issue I money. It may delay it, but it is fiscally responsible. We will do our best and some of the factors are not in our control

Dave Gillis of McCreary Jacoby Road:

- Back in 2020 we passed a 6 mill levy for roads and all we see are cold patching and chip coating. The residents are wondering where the money is going

Ted McDivitt of Diamond Way in Cortland City:

- Inquired about rental fees for the Township Hall June 10, 11 and 12 for speakers Pre pandemic they charged \$90.00 days. Trustee Morelli asked how long he has been renting the hall and Mr McDivitt replied for about 5 years. Trustee Morelli explained they are looking at the fees

Stanley Shrodek of Lakeshore Drive:

- Asked Superintendent Parke if the crew is working on the roads or in the cemetery. Superintendent replied they are working on the roads, cemetery and park.
- Stanley Shrodek explained on lakeshore and Westlake there are cracks and if they aren't addressed, they will be worse next year.
- Superintendent Parke explained Trustee Hovis is putting together a plan for the roads and would ask that we hold off till we see what the plan is. There is nothing that can be done now. He explained the procedures for Chip Sealing roads
- Superintendent Parke explained the legacy cost of the one and a half million-dollar project (numbers are not exact) on the 16-year project if they use the \$600,00.00 dollars from the ARP money its about 16 years at \$60,000.00 a year and outside of that we will not be able to do anything else
- Trustee Hovis noted its only 5.21 miles of roadway and Kris has 20.41 miles so its 6 million dollars to pave all of our roads. Our .6 mill levy was a replacement levy that generated about \$90,000.00 dollars and is probably about \$85,000.00 dollars now at today's valuation.
- Stanley Shrodek asked if the trustees have designated funds strictly for maintaining the roads
- Trustee Hovis explained in January they met with the Teamsters Union and cut the secretary position from full tie to part time and that money can go towards infrastructure projects and some of those funds can be used for roads. They are putting together a plan and it's going to take a while and at least two of the trustees will have to agree on it. We are using the money differently than they have in the past. Mark Thomas Ford donated a vehicle to us at a time when his vehicle is old and in bad shape. Trustee Morelli has done a lot of projects in the park We spent our own money there but we spend our own money without increasing taxes.
- Trustee Morelli added the new paving at the park was funded by the ODNR.
