The levy type is a renewal starting in tax year 2023, commencing in 2024 for a five (5) year period.
2. The estimated property tax revenue that will be produced by the stated millage, assuming tax valuation of the subdivision remains constant throughout the life of the levy, is calculated to be \$ 193,008.



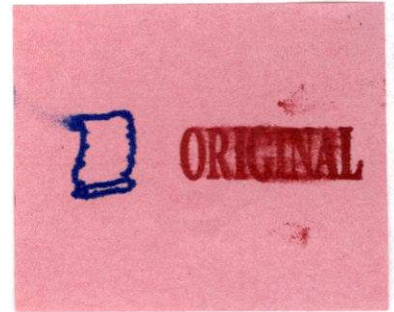

RESOLUTION 134-22
OF THE TRUSTEES
OF BAZETTA TOWNSHIP
DECLARING IT NECESSARY TO LEVY A TAX
IN EXCESS OF TEN MILL LIMITATION



The Board of Trustees of Bazetta Township, Trumbull County, Ohio, met in regular session on the 9 day of August 2022, at Bazetta Township Administration Building with the following members present:

Michael Hovis
Michael Morelli
Robert McBride

Trustee Morelli moved for the adoption of the following Resolution:

WHEREAS, the amount of taxes which may be raised within the 10 mill limitation will be insufficient to provide an adequate amount for the necessary requirements of said Bazetta Township, Trumbull County, Ohio; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to levy a tax under R.C. 5705.19(I) in excess of the ten mill limitation and the Board of Trustees has previously certified to the County Auditor of Trumbull County, Ohio, a resolution requesting the County Auditor certify to the Board of Trustees the total current tax valuation of Bazetta Township and the total amount of revenue that would generated by a renewal levy of 2.0 mills, in excess of the ten mill limitation.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of Bazetta Township, Trumbull County, Ohio, two-thirds of all members elected thereto concurring that it is necessary to levy a tax in excess of the 10 mill limitation for a renewal tax for the benefit of Bazetta Township pursuant to R.C. 5705.19(I) in order to provide sufficient fire, ambulance and emergency medical services to all inhabitants of the Township at a rate not exceeding 2.0 mills for each one dollar of

valuation, which amounts to (\$0.20) twenty cents for each one hundred dollars of valuation for a five year period of time, commencing tax year 2023, first collected in calendar year 2024; said levy being a renewal levy of 2.0 mills; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the specific purpose of the renewal levy will be for:

providing and maintaining fire apparatus, appliances, buildings, or sites therefore, or sources of water supply and materials therefore, or the establishment and maintenance of lines of fire alarm telegraph, or the payment of permanent, part-time, or volunteer firefighter personnel or fire fighting companies to operate the same, including the payment of firefighter employer's contribution required under section 742.34 of the Ohio Revised Code, or to purchase ambulance equipment, or to provide ambulance, paramedic, or other emergency medical services operated by a fire department or fire fighting company


