As we discussed, my appearance fee for evening hearings is \$85 for up to the first hour (which is a minimum fee), and then I bill in 15 minute increments thereafter. If a transcript is ordered there is an extra charge, and it is based on the number of pages generated by the hearing. I had mentioned to you that the only regular monthly evening obligation I have is the third Tuesday of every month, so I would not be available for hearings on those dates.
